# **DAY 5: SUNRISE - GRINZANE CAVOUR**



Travelling back through the unique landscape of the narrow valley of the Quarry of Ispica that was used as a necropolis and troglodytic dwelling place s, as well as Christian catacombs, you will arrive at the hotel late afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

# DAY 4: **NOTO**

Breakfast. This morning you will have a tour of Noto, the capital the Baroque Ages, with UNESCO World Heritage status. At leisure the rest of the day. Typical dinner at Marzamemi, an old fishing village with its ancient "tonnara" (tuna fish works).
