
Cinque Terre, Florence and The Flavours of Tuscany

Tour in English with guaranteed departures, min 1 pax 6 days 5 nights Start: Milan End: Rome



Accommodation for the first night will be at CDH Hotel La Spezia, a 4-star hotel.

Nights 2 and 3 will be spent at Hotel Pitti Palace at Ponte Vecchio, a 4-star hotel or Hotel Laurus at Duomi, a 4-star hotel.

Nights 4 and 5 will be spent at Hotel Albergo San Biagio, a 3-star hotel.

The "Cinque Terre, Florence and The Flavours of Tuscany" tour lasts 6 days, from April to November, starting from Milan and ending in Rome. It is possible to combine this tour with others to create 13-day itineraries.

The tour includes 5 nights in 3-4 star hotels. There is a 20 kg baggage limit per person and meal expenses are not included.


Cinque Terre, Florence and The Flavours of Tuscany

Day 1: Milano – La Spezia – Cinque Terre (217 km + treno)

Departure from Milan with a stop along the way and arrival in La Spezia

After checking into hotel, travel by train to Cinque Terre in the afternoon, visiting two of Liguria's famous villages overlooking the sea

Free return to La Spezia





After leaving La Spezia, short visit to Pietrasanta and then stop in Pisa with free time to admire the Leaning Tower and the Campo dei Miracoli


In the afternoon, reach Lucca for a stroll through the historic center before the evening arrival in Florence


Day 2: La Spezia – Pietrasanta – Pisa – Lucca – Firenze (202 km)

Day 3: Free day in Florence

Full day at leisure to explore the Renaissance city: museums, churches, Tuscan art and cuisine

Overnight stay in Florence





Day 4: Firenze – Castellina in Chianti – San Gimignano – Siena – Montepulciano (194 km)

Departure from Florence to Castellina in Chianti, then visit and free lunch in San Gimignano

In the afternoon, continue to Siena with an orientation walk through the historic center

The day ends with arrival in Montepulciano


Day 5: Montepulciano – Pienza – Cantina Solaria – Bagno Vignoni – Montepulciano (78 km)

Free morning in Montepulciano, then visit to the village of Pienza

Followed by a stop at a winery in the Montalcino area for a wine tasting

Last stop of the day: Bagno Vignoni with a visit to the archaeological area and ancient baths





Day 6: Montepulciano – Sovana – Capodimonte – Roma (247 km)

Optional visit to the Etruscan necropolis of Sovana, followed by a break in the village

Continue to Capodimonte, on Lake Bolsena, with the possibility of walking or relaxing on the lakefront

Arrival in Rome in the evening and end of the tour
